Weights	Common Containers
1 pound = 1,280 tabs	1 Pringles can = 1/3 pound
789 pounds = 1 million tabs	Sandwich sized Ziploc = .5 pounds
Measurements	1/2 gallon jug = 1.5 pounds
1 inch = 1 tab	2 liter bottle = 1.75 pounds
1 foot = 12 tabs	Large oatmeal container = 2 pounds
1 yard = 36 tabs	Gallon milk jug = 3 pounds
1 mile = 63,360 tabs	1 copy paper box = 24 pounds
16 miles = 1 million tabs	32 gallon trash can = 80 pounds
